

Sizzling Science @ RSC

The Royal Society of Chemistry (RSC) is once again running its Chemistry Week this year. Chemistry Week 2009 will take place between Saturday 7th and Sunday 15th November 2009 and the theme will be 'Food.'

As part of this event, HNR will be running another series of Sizzling Science Cookery Demonstrations on Wednesday 11th November at 10am, 12.30pm and 2pm. Grant Hawthorne from The Craft Guild of Chefs will be creating a 3-course meal that is healthy, affordable and easy to make, whilst our nutrition scientists describe the science that is going on during the cooking.

The aim of this event will be to highlight the collision between science and food in the kitchen, whilst promoting recipes that the whole family can prepare in the kitchen. We will be offering alternatives throughout the demonstration so that these meals can be tried and tested on any budget.

Chemistry Week is a themed week of events that is held every two years to promote a positive image of chemistry and increase the public understanding of the importance of chemical science in our everyday lives.
